
2. Becket Ravine - North Becket



Becket Ravine – Becket, MA

Location: Brooker Hill Road, North Becket. (Berkshire County)

Parking GPS: N42° 19' 51.60" W73° 5' 15.20"

Destination GPS: N42°19' 51.24" W73° 5' 18.25" (View Point)

Wow Factor: 7 Accessibility: No marked paths, short walk 0.1mile-RT

Information: This location is just a stone throw from the center of North Becket. While many have called it "Becket Center Falls," it is correct and now better known as the "Becket Ravine." At one time the hub and center of activities for the Becket Township was in North Becket. Presently, the development in the geographic center of Becket is correctly referred to as Becket Center.

While parking is limited, the cascading falls are impressive, making the venture down to the cascading falls worth the effort. Swimming not applicable.

Directions: From the center of Becket Village on Route-8, take Brooker Hill Road uphill for .2 of a mile. A small pull off for one car is located on the right side of the Road between the guard rails. Over the embankment of hemlocks you'll see Mill/Morgan Brook below and the Becket Ravine. While no postings about parking or access has been seen, some of the abutting land may be posted so be wary of trespassing.
