Land Trust.

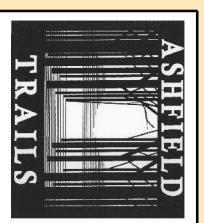
Construction was made possible

Conservation and Recreation.



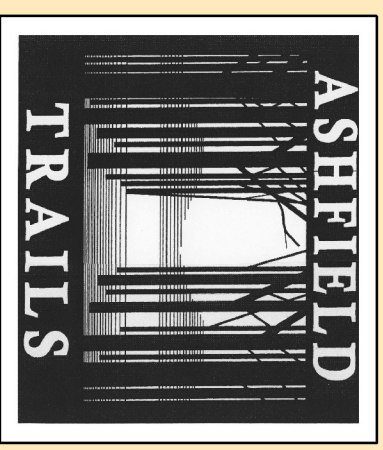
The trail is approximately three
miles long and is of moderate
difficulty. A round trip hike takes
between 4 and 5 hours. Among
the many historical, cultural and
environmental features are old
foundations, rock walls, ledges
and meandering streams cross-
ed by plank bridges.

the land with respect and stay
on marked trails. The following
are not permitted: motorized
vehicles, littering, camping,
campfires, hunting, trapping,
picking or removing plants,
wildflowers, trees or other
vegetation.
